"FINDS" The Steps in the Research Cycle

Focus on the information need

- What is the problem to be solved?
- What types of information are needed to solve the problem?

Investigate resources to look for an
answer

- What are the possible sources of information?
- Which are the best of all the possibilities?

Note and evaluate facts

- What information does the source provide?
- How can you extract the information you need?

Develop information into knowledge for
presentation

- How does the information from all the sources fit together?
- How is the information best presented?

Score presentation and search

- Was the information problem solved?
- If the problem had to be solved again, what would you do differently?
