6. \$60.00 (**\$30.00 when after January 1, 2021**). *Senior Parking spot add an additional \$15.*
7. Parking stickers must be displayed on the top passenger side of the rear window (NO EXCEPTIONS).

In order to obtain a parking decal, the student must have a cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.0 or higher. If that GPA dips below the 2.0 threshold, your parking permit will be revoked. It can also be revoked for violation of attendance/tardy policies or discipline issues.

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Application Procedures:

1. Students are to complete the Parking Permit Form, sign the application form, and clear any fees or fines with the Bookkeeper in building 100.
2. Each student receiving a parking permit will be assigned a specific numbered spot and must park in that spot or a parking ticket will be issued.
3. Wekiva High School reserves the right to deny any student the privilege of parking based on his or her attendance, disciplinary history, or GPA.
4. Present the completed application, a photocopy of your valid Florida Driver License, proof of insurance, valid vehicle registration, and \$60.00 in designated area to receive a decal.
5. **THIS SHALL SERVE AS NOTICE THAT WEKIVA HIGH SCHOOL AND THE SCHOOL BOARD OF ORANGE COUNTY ARE NOT LIABLE FOR ANY VANDALISM TO, THEFT OF OR FROM, VEHICLES PARKED ON THE PROPERTY.**

The undersigned student hereby applies to the Orange County School Board (OCSB) for a student parking decal. In making this application, I understand, acknowledge, and agree to the following conditions as a prerequisite to, and in consideration for, the issuance of a student parking decal that authorizes me to drive and park on an OCSB school campus.

- A. I agree that it is a privilege, not a right, to have an OCSB student parking decal, drive or park on an OCSB school campus. I agree that if I fail to comply with OCSB policy, the policies of my school, and/or the conditions contained in this application, OCSB may immediately revoke my student parking decal and parking privilege.
- B. I agree that the student parking decal that I am issued and the parking space I use shall remain the property of the OCSB.
- C. I hereby waive any expectation of privacy in any vehicle (and its contents) that I drive or park on any OCSB campus.
- D. I hereby give consent and authorize the OCSB, its employees and agents, and any law enforcement officer of any agency located within the State of Florida, to open and search my vehicle and its contents at any time without prior notice or additional consent and without my knowledge or presence. I specifically waive the provisions of Florida Statute 232.256 and consent to the use of animals (such as dogs) trained to detect weapons and/or drugs.
- E. I hereby give consent and authorize the OCSB, its employees and agents, and/or any law enforcement of any agency located within the State of Florida to open and search any vehicle (and its contents) that I drive or park on an OCSB school campus at any time, without prior notice or additional consent and without my knowledge or presence.
- F. I understand that if I refuse to cooperate with the search of my vehicle pursuant to this agreement, OCSB may have the vehicle immediately towed or removed from the school campus at the owner's expense.
- G. I agree that I am responsible for the contents of any vehicle I drive, and that I am not authorized to, and will not allow any other person to share or place anything in such vehicle.
- H. I agree that the OCSB and its officers, agents, or employees, and any and all law enforcement personnel shall not be responsible and are released from any liability for any theft, loss, and/or damage to my vehicle while on an OCSB school campus, and I agree that the OCSB and all law enforcement agencies are hereby released and held harmless from all liability, claims or damages connected with the search of a vehicle on an OCSB school campus, or from the removal of a vehicle as provided above.

PARKING LOT RULES:

- A. **WEKIVA HIGH SCHOOL IS A CLOSED CAMPUS.** Students must have their parent/guardian sign them in when late, or sign them out if leaving early from the attendance office.
- B. Safe driving procedures are to be followed at all times. The Speed Limit is ten (10) miles per hour on campus. You are subject to being ticketed and losing your permit for speed violations.

- C. Loud and/or offensive music is NOT permitted.
- D. A Student who parks in a space not assigned to him/her, parks in an unauthorized area, or does not move his/her vehicle at the time designated will be “booted.” The student must pay a \$25 fine in order to have the boot removed.
- E. The school parking lot is a closed area of the campus from 7:00AM until school is dismissed. School personnel have the authority to stop, check, and verify information from any student in the parking lot.
- F. If a student with a parking permit is late to school five (5) times during a nine week marking period his or her parking permit will be suspended until the following nine (9) week marking period starts.
- G. Students must not sit in or on, or loiter around cars at any time.
- H. Misuse of parking permits (putting your permit on an unauthorized vehicle or giving your permit to another student) is not permitted.
- I. If a decal is lost, stolen, damaged, etc., a new decal must be obtained and you must update your application.
- J. The parking permit decal must be affixed to the upper passenger side rear window. NO EXCEPTIONS.
